Heady fruit aromas with some lime in the background and ripe gooseberry and passion fruit characters.

Daniel Dampt (France)

Terrain Winery (France)

Bright salmon pink, fresh and brimming with cherry and strawberry aromas. An instantly refreshing glass.

19. **CABERNET-GARNACHA NAVARRA ROSADO 2007/8** £16.95
Bodegas Nekeas (Spain)
Enticing red cherry and strawberry flavours together with a refreshing, dry palate. Great with most Asian cuisine.

Terrain Winery (France)
An easy drinking red wine with warming blackcurrant fruit and a hint of spice on the palate.
21. **MERLOT 2007/8** £13.95

22. **SHIRAZ-CINSAULT 2007** £14.95
Broken Rock (South Africa)

A rich and spicy blend cascading with natural plum and blackcurrant flavours. From the rolling hills of Argeliers, South West France.
24. **MALBEC 'Altas Cumbres' 2008** £16.95
Bodegas Lagarde (Argentina)
Deep, smooth plummy palate together with lingering black fruit, dried figs and cassis on the nose.
25. **SHIRAZ 'Filigree' 2006/7** £17.50
Beelgara Estate (Australia)
Vibrant crimson colour and brimming with black fruit aromas. Hints of blueberry on the palate. Good with most spicy dishes.

26. **PINOT NOIR 2006/7** £17.95
Bernard d'Assigny (France)

Soft and rich strawberry and damson fruit flavours with a delicate but powerful finish. Produced in the Languedoc – South West France.

27. **COTES du RHONE 'Roulepievre' 2007** **£19.95**
Pierre Amadieu (France)
Smooth, rich and aromatic with subtle red berry and cherry fruit. Produced deep in the Rhone Valley – a real treat.
28. **RIOJA TINTO CRIANZA 2005** **£23.95**
Bodegas Tobia (Spain)
Rich, smoky berry flavours with hints of vanilla, cassis and integrated oak. A fine example of Rioja from a well respected Bodega.

29. **MARQUIS de la COUR ROSE NV** **£16.95**
A pale pink colour, fine bubbles with a red fruit aroma of raspberries and redcurrants. Supple with a fruity finish.
30. **GRUET BRUT SELECTION NV** **£32.50**
Brilliant gold in colour with honey and peach flavours and a long fresh finish.
31. **BOLLINGER SPECIAL CUVÉE NV** **£48.50**
Lingering fruity flavours of apple and pear on the palate create fresh, harmonious and lively Champagne.
